Experienced TCVM speaker in different countries such as the United States. China, Taiwan, ,Southafrica, Denmark, Spain, Portugal, Italy, France... Senior lecturer at the International Veterinary College (Shanghai), speaker and lab leader at the Chi Institute China in collaboration with the University of Hebei (China), Founding member and director of the Chi Institute of Europe since 2008, Chi Europe is the European branch of the College of TCVM Chi Institute of Chinese Medicine in Florida, USA dedicated to veterinary graduate training with university validation. Lorena Lloret has published numerous articles and papers about TCVM in different countries (Spain, EEUU, China) also been editor chief of the Spanish translation of the reference book "TCVM Fundamental Principals" into Spanish. Her article on the integrative use of EA as an anesthetic agent in routine surgical procedures has been published by the prestigious American Journal of TCVM and is a reference for integrative veterinarians worldwide. She is part of the Board of Directors of the World Association of MVTC (WATCVM), and co-director of the Council of Curriculum Education of this same association Co-founder and president of the Spanish Association of TCVM (AEMVTC) since 2013.
